PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS:

Each RCL student must fully commit to the RCL Program for the entire Academic Year, running fall and spring semesters (Note: The RCL Program does not operate during the summer)

Each RCL partnership facilitates at least two on-site activities and promotes two on-campus activities each month

All RCLs are required to attend Student Leadership and Involvement Leadership Lectures twice a semester that will help strengthen leadership skill sets

RCLs are required to attend various trainings and workshops throughout the year that will help them gain valuable skills that they are expected to apply to their leadership as RCLs

Full-time Student Status at UVU (12 credits or more)

Physical ability to lift equipment unaccompanied

The success and life balance of students is at the forefront of the mission of the Department of Student Leadership and Involvement (SLI). Because of this priority, students involved in the SLI student leadership programs will need to be committed to their positions and the time commitment they entail. Students are discouraged from and will not be selected if they are involved in extracurricular activities for participation (part time jobs, hobbies, additional student leadership opportunities, etc.) that exceed 20-25 hours per week. Furthermore, students that are offered multiple positions amongst the various SLI student leadership programs will be expected to select only one program to participate in

PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS:

Each RCL is required to attend office hours every Tuesday and Thursday from 2-4PM

Each RCL is required to attend the mini-retreat in May, the fall retreat in August and the spring retreat

2.50 Cumulative GPA or higher when applying and a maintained 2.50 GPA each semester

Successfully pass a background check

RCLs are expected each week to plan events, meet deadlines, manage budgets, create marketing materials and successfully fulfill all responsibilities as assigned

UVU RCL's must be willing and able to complete a minimum of 8-10 hours per week, to fulfill their RCL responsibilities. Because of this time commitment, RCL members are not permitted to participate in additional UVU extracurricular activities that exceed 5 hours per week

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
