

* GETTING STARTED at UVU

1 APPLY TO UVU Complete the online application at www.uvu.edu/admissions and pay the application fee. The admissions deadline for fall semester is August 15 and for spring is December 20.

After 48 hours, you will need to access your UVU student e-mail account by going to www.uvu.edu and clicking on UVLink. This e-mail account is where ALL OFFICIAL UVU communications will be sent.

2 COMPLETE WEBSTART PRE-ADVISEMENT

- Go to www.uvu.edu and click on UVLink click on the link titled, "How do I find my UV ID?" The first time you login to UV Link, your password will be your birthday (mmddyy).
- Click "Webstart" and begin the pre-advisement session. This will take about 20 minutes to complete.
- Print out your completion certificate and bring it to the meeting with your advisor.

3 SUBMIT ACT OR SAT SCORES AND HIGH SCHOOL TRANSCRIPT Test scores are required for all students under age 21 who have not completed 15 or more college credits. Send official test and transcript materials to the **Admissions Office (MS 106)**. Placement testing may be needed if one of the following conditions exists:

- ACT/SAT expired scores: Math scores must be less than two years old; English/reading scores must be less than three.
- ACT/SAT non-expired scores are too low: ACT math 19 or SAT math 540. ACT English 10 or SAT writing 450. ACT reading 10 or SAT writing 450.
- Student is entering UVU as a first-time college student over age 21 (as of the first day of class).
- College credit equivalent (AP, CLEP, transfer) to UVU's ENGL 1010 and/or MAT 1010 or higher is not posted to UVU transcript.

The UVU Placement Test is available at no charge in the Assessment Center, which is located in the **Wolverine Service Center (WSC), room 101**. More information is available at www.uvu.edu/testingservices or (801) 863-8269.

4 REGISTER FOR ORIENTATION Orientation events are designed to make your transition to university life a success and to introduce you to the many services, programs and other resources available at UVU. 5 MEET WITH YOUR ACADEMIC ADVISOR After completing the above steps, you will meet with an advisor to get personalized help and be cleared for registration. 6 REGISTER FOR CLASSES Log on to UV Link at uvlink.uvu.edu. Select "Registration" menu then click "Look up classes to add." For questions regarding registration, call **One Stop** at (801) 863-4636.

7 PAY TUITION To access UVU's online payment services, log on to UVLink and locate the "tuition payment" box under the "student" tab. Important payment deadlines and purge dates may be found on the student semester timetable located at www.uvu.edu/schedule/timetables. For more information, contact the **Cashiers Office** at (801) 863-8298 or 8299.

Financial Aid or Scholarships Apply for scholarships at www.uvu.edu/financialaid/scholarships. Apply for federal and state aid in four steps: (1) Obtain a PIN at www.pin.ed.gov. (2) Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at www.fafsa.ed.gov. (3) Check UVLink at www.uvu.edu for your financial aid status and to read important e-mail notices.

ID card After you have registered and paid tuition, get a UV OneCard/UV PlusCard at Campus Connection, located in the Sorensen Student Center. Your UV OneCard/UV PlusCard gives you access to the UVU library, athletic events, student activities, computer labs and a 5 percent discount at UVU Dining Services. Activate your UTA Bus Pass for \$5 or for free if you get a UV PlusCard
