

TRANSFERRING to UVU

1 APPLY TO UVU Admissions Office: (801) 863-8466 www.uvu.edu/admissions

Complete the online application at www.uvu.edu/admissions and pay the application fee. The admissions deadline for fall semester is August 15 and for spring it is December 20. After 48 hours you will need to access your UVU student e-mail account by going to www.uvu.edu and clicking on UVLink. This e-mail account is where ALL OFFICIAL UVU communications will be sent. Be sure to check your UVU email often for news, notices, etc. A welcome packet with all pertinent information will also be sent to you in the mail within one week of applying.

2 TRANSFERRING YOUR CLASSES (FROM A USHE SCHOOL) Transfer Advisor: (801) 863-8438 www.uvu.edu/transfer

UVU will accept at full value all general education course work approved by Utah State Higher Education (USHE) institutions (with a "C-" grade or higher received). UVU requires transfer students to complete any additional coursework needed to satisfy the unmet portions of the UVU general education requirements. Previously completed General Studies course work will be applied to ensure the best possible fit with UVU general education requirements. An Associate in Science/Arts degree earned at any USHE institution will meet the general education requirements of UVU (with one exception - all students must meet the American Institutions requirement). Some majors may require students to complete specific general education courses. Make sure to send your official transcripts to UVU 4-6 weeks prior to registration for evaluation. To send in your **official transcripts**, contact all institutions you have previously attended and request official transcripts be mailed to UVU admissions. 3 APPLY FOR FINANCIAL AID/SCHOLARSHIPS Financial Aid: (801) 863-8442 www.uvu.edu/finaid

Transfer students must have 30 credits or more to apply for scholarships; visit www.uvsc.edu/finaid/scholarships/ for information on how to apply. Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at www.fafsa.ed.gov. The sooner you apply the better. Results of the FAFSA must be received by the Financial Aid Office by the first priority date of May 1 to guarantee financial aid by the beginning of school! UVU's FAFSA school code is 004027.

You MUST meet with an advisor! This will help you understand the registration process and will clarify transfer questions. They will also release your academic hold so you can register for classes. To register for classes log in to your UVLink account at <http://uvlink.uvu.edu>. Once you've logged into your UVLink account, select the "Registration" menu then select "Look-up Classes to Add". Use the search tool to find specific courses. Select the check box next to the courses to add them to your schedule. 6 RESIDENCY Residency Advisor: (801) 863-8464 www.uvsc.edu/students/residency

Effective July 1, 2008, students who are not claimed on a tax return of any person who is not a resident of Utah will be eligible to apply for residency after having lived in Utah for just one year. This means new students residing in Utah for 12 continuous months who are financially independent will be able to apply for residency as early as July 1, 2008. A Utah drivers license and Utah vehicle registration must also be obtained three months prior to applying for residency.
