Now is the time to start filling out scholarship applications and making the choice of where to go to college. If you are looking for a competitive advantage and a jump-start for your personal and professional development, The Center for the Advancement of Leadership at Utah Valley University has just what you need.


We offer several different scholarships that allow you to get involved, give service, network with the best and the brightest, while building your leadership potential and having fun during your college experience.

- **The Presidential Leadership Scholarship** is a 2/3rds housing scholarship, where students live together in authorized Apartments. This creates a fun atmosphere and opportunity for students to learn and work as a “community of leaders” while pursuing leadership certification alongside their degree.
- **Technology Leadership Scholarship** offers a half-tuition scholarship for students interested in a technology and/or computing career and in the Leadership Certification Program.
- Private scholarships offered through UVU’s scholarship application process.
  - You must be admitted to UVU [www.uvu.edu/admissions](http://www.uvu.edu/admissions) and have a UV ID # then, log on to [www.uvu.edu/financialaid/scholarships](http://www.uvu.edu/financialaid/scholarships)
  - Select 2010/2011 Scholarship application and fill out all fields, including the CAL Presidential Leadership Scholarship.
  - Give special attention to the Essay portion and follow all instructions for full points. It is best to copy and paste your essay and “Letter of Intent” from a Word doc. Please make sure you explain your goals and why you want this scholarship and how you can contribute to the CAL program.
  - Take your ACT as soon as possible for the best scholarships! Applications need to be in early (between October and December is recommended!)
  - Students who have attended UVU’s Annual Leadership Conference, and/or participated in the Concurrent Enrollment leadership course (Principles of Leadership MGMT 1250) will be given priority in the selection process and should mention this in their essay.
