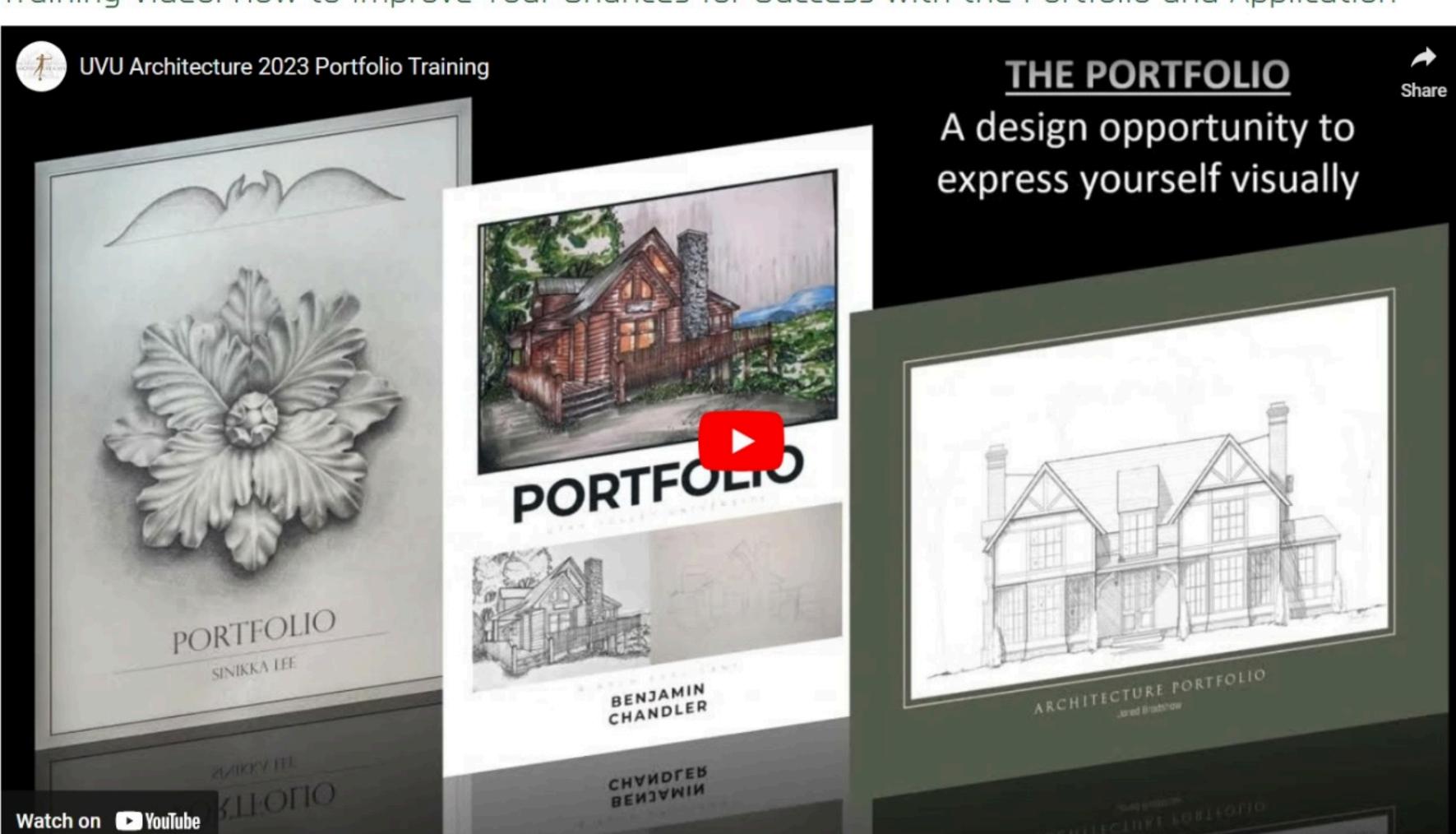


Training Video: How to Improve Your Chances for Success with the Portfolio and Application

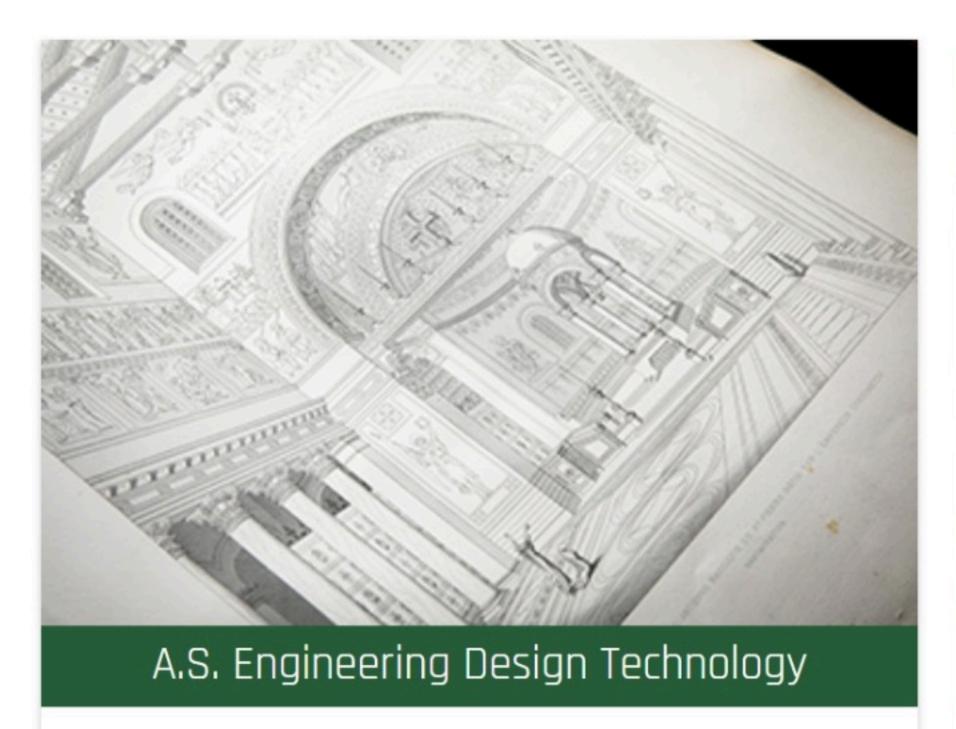


Overview of the Admissions Process

Architectural education at Utah Valley University consists of the following two degrees:

- A.S. Engineering Design Technology (Architectural Drafting and Design Track)
- Bachelor of Architecture (B-Arch)

Both degrees require an admissions application in the Spring semester prior to the Fall semester to which they would like to be admitted. Transfer credits must be approved by the Architecture Program Coordinator in writing.



After being admitted to the university, students interested in a career in architecture should declare their major and apply for the Architectural Drafting and Design track of the A.S. in Engineering Design Technology degree. This degree allows a student to pursue entry-level employment as a drafter in the architectural industry. Only those who complete this track are eligible for matriculation into the B.Arch degree program.

Applications are submitted during the Spring semester of the first year of coursework. The deadline for applications is March 18th. To apply, students submit the following items as an email attachment to ARCHADMISSIONS@uvu.edu. All attachments should be submitted as a

- Application Form Portfolio (5 pages of your creative work)
- Statement of Intent (250 words)
- Unofficial University Transcript Resume of work history
