Additional notes from Laurie related to these measures:

Near-term initiatives: Support OTL pedagogical training and continue building and enhancing existing training and support.

- Establish and implement robust recruitment, onboarding, and retention practices for faculty members
- Continuous improvement of RTP processes and criteria
