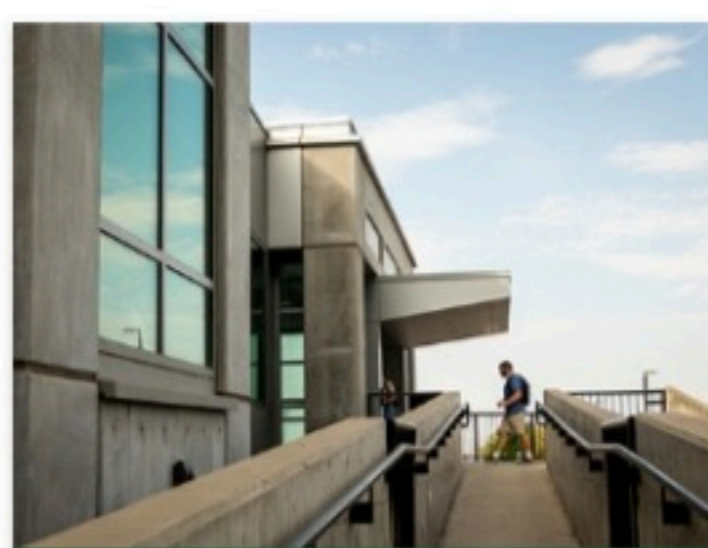

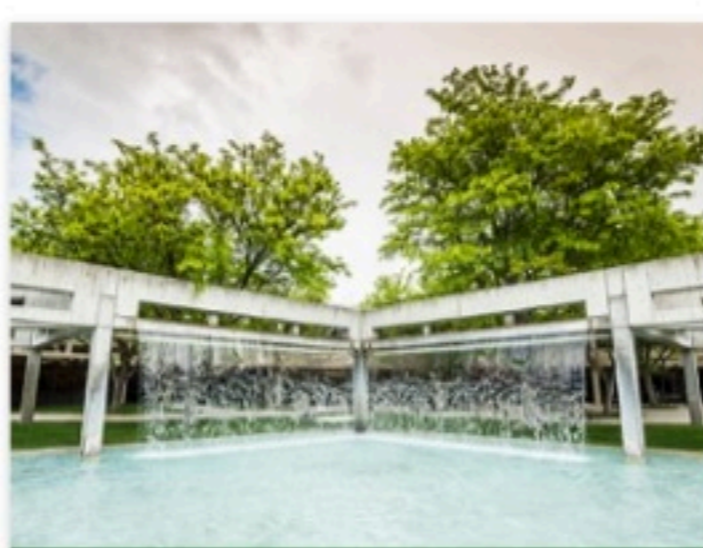

The following information may be helpful if you have been accused of sex assault, discrimination, dating or domestic violence, stalking, or some other gender related harassment.

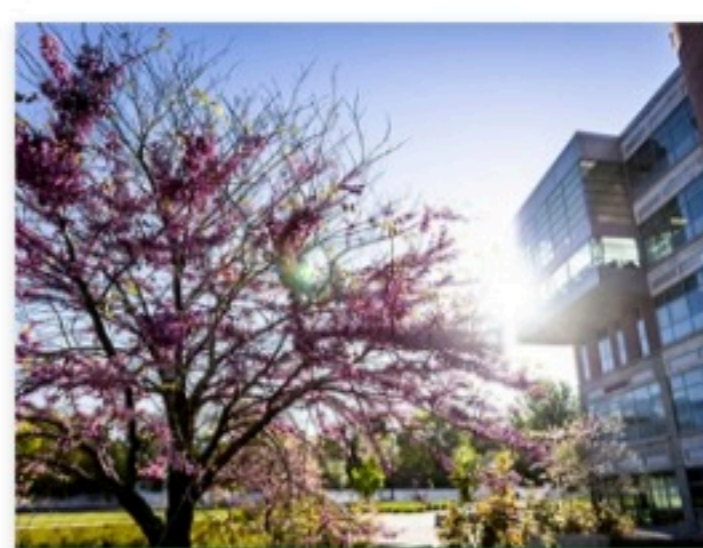

Language Access

The Equity and Title IX Office recognizes the importance of being able to communicate effectively with individuals, including those with limited English proficiency. A limited English proficient (LEP) person is someone who does not speak English as their primary language, and has a limited ability to read, speak, write, or understand English.

According to the U.S. Census Bureau, the top five languages spoken in Utah County, Utah by individuals who are LEP are: **Spanish, Chinese, Korean, Portuguese, and Japanese.**
