


In Spring 2023, I received the General Education course review decision for ENGL 2010. The General Education Committee provided the following recommendations for improvements:

The committee suggests considering ways to integrate opportunities for students to examine and explore the relationships among language, power, and knowledge (question WR 4.1). In considering, question WR 5.1 it may also be worthwhile to consider ways/modes of representing language, thought, and or argument.

In Fall 2023, I presented the General Education Committee's recommendations to faculty who teach the ENGL 2010 course.

Regarding the first recommendation made for Question WR 4.1, faculty have opted to address this recommendation. Currently, faculty are actively involved in endeavors to incorporate opportunities for students to investigate and delve into the connections between language, power, and knowledge within the ENGL 2010 course.

Regarding the second recommendation made for Question WR 5.1, faculty concurred that exploring methods of representing language, thought, and argument was valuable. Nonetheless, faculty have chosen to hold this recommendation under consideration without any specific action being pursued at this time.
