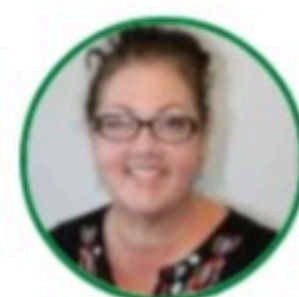

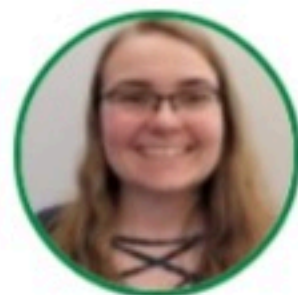

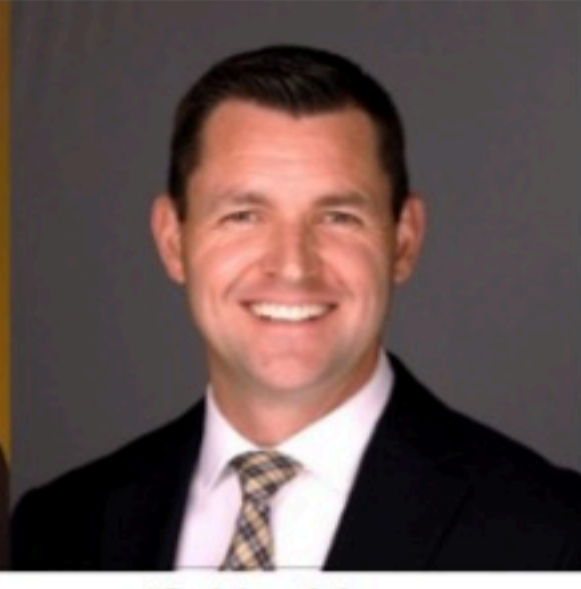

 - Encourage, motivate faculty to participate – how? Reach out to Deans.
