Admissions Requirements & Prerequisites

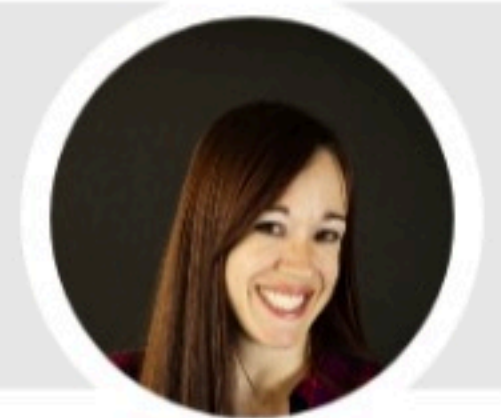
To be considered for admissions, individuals interested in earning their M.Ed. at UVU must successfully complete all admission criteria*:
