- A dedicated leadership team:
 - Led by the associate provost for student success in the Academic Affairs Division, this team focuses on developing and implementing strategies to improve student success in English and math courses within UVU's General Education program.
- A math placement preparation course:
 - o This course helps students prepare for the math placement exam, ensuring they are placed in the appropriate math course for their skill level.
- Corequisite courses in first-college-level-course in English and mathematics:
 - o These courses combine lecture and lab components, providing students with additional support and resources to succeed in these critical subjects.
- Faculty actively monitor student progress in corequisite courses to identify areas for improvement and provide targeted support.
- Academic Affairs tracks overall completion rates in English and math courses within UVU's General Education program to measure the effectiveness of student completion initiatives and make data-driven decisions to further enhance student success.
