Writing Consultations

IN PERSON

In-person consultations allow writers to meet with a writing consultant in the Writing Center (FL 208) to review and practice writing concepts, share resources, and discuss the writer's work and plans for writing and revision.

ONLINE

Online consultations allow writers to meet with a writing consultant in real time and in a shared online writing space to review and practice writing concepts, share resources, and discuss the writer's work and plans for writing and revision.

VIDEO FEEDBACK

Video feedback consultations are an asynchronous service that allows writers to upload up to five pages of their writing along with assignment guidelines for a writing consultant to review and provide formative feedback in a short, personalized video.

Graduate Writing Center

The Graduate Writing Center (GWC) provides one-on-one writing consultations and resources for UVU graduate students, UVU faculty and staff, and writers applying to graduate school.
