
SOCIO-ECONOMIC STATUS FOR STUDENTS AT UVU



About 1 in 3 students comes from a household that makes less than \$20,000 a year. Around 19% of students come from households making more than the median income of Utah County, and 6.3% of students come from census block groups with a median income less than 200% of the Federal Poverty Level.



Despite the diverse economic backgrounds of UVU students, according to the National Survey of Student Engagement (2018), UVU is below our peers in the frequency that students have discussions with people whose economic backgrounds are different from their own (First-year students report a 10 percentage point difference; seniors an 8 percentage point difference).
