


MINORITY POPULATIONS IN 2015




White, Hispanic, and Other Minority students all report very similar levels of satisfaction with their overall experience at UVU (88% -90% Excellent or Good)

Other Minority students report the most UVU pride (52% Very High or High) followed by White students (43%) and Hispanic students (36%).

Hispanic students are most likely to report that their fellow students treat them with appropriate respect (91% Almost Always) followed by White students (85%) and Other Minority students (72%).

Other Minority students are most likely to agree that they know what to do if they receive a report of harassment (81% Strongly Agree or Agree) followed by White students (71%) and Hispanic students (58%).
