

Follow the steps outlined below to get academic credit for your internship. There may be **additional** requirements associated with your internship course.

- 1 Identify internship sites that match your skills, interests and goals by meeting with your **internship coordinator**.
- Find an internship. Several resources can be found by visiting our Find Internships page. Talking to faculty and other students is a good idea as well.
- Develop a cover letter and resume and prepare for interviews. For resources go to UVU Career Development Center website.
- Meet with your academic advisor or refer back to your internship coordinator to discuss your ability to gain academic credit for your internship.
- 5 Complete the online Internship Orientation Training.
- 6 Complete the appropriate **Application for Academic Credit.**

- 7 Upon application approval, register for your internship course.
- Arrange to communicate with your internship coordinator and faculty supervisor throughout the semester.
- Meet with your internship site supervisor to discuss progress and goals, have them complete the **Site Supervisor Evaluation** (Canvas Course) near the end of your experience.
