

Learners with Littles Session II: American Revolution

Lesson for Children

- Instructor reads *[George Washington the First President](#)*
- Emphasis on
 - George Washington was the commander of the army during the Revolutionary War.
 - Washington's flag when he was in camp looks like...
 - Show an image of George Washington's headquarters flag from the Revolutionary War.
 - The astronaut John Glenn brought a reproduction of this flag to space. [Here is a picture of that reproduction](#) from the Museum of the American Revolution in Philadelphia.
 - Washington had the opportunity to be king of America, but he wanted America to be self-governed, so he chose to retire and go home.
 - Washington became the first U.S. president
 - Everyone wanted Washington to continue as president, but he chose to retire and go home so presidents that follow did not serve for life.
- **Toddlers can dismiss to their table if they are wiggly, but may like what's coming up**
- Instructor reads section from *[The First Spymaster: George Washington and the Culper Spy Ring](#)*
 - Washington was a spymaster during the Revolutionary War
 - The Culper Spy Ring was the most important group of spies
 - Operated on Long Island New York to get information about New York City
 - Spy: Abraham Woodhull—cabbage farmer
 - Spy: Caleb Brewster—owned and operated a whale boat
 - Spy: Anna Strong—her husband was imprisoned by the British and she helped to pass on messages
 - Anna Strong would use her laundry as a signal. If she hung her black petticoat, it signaled to Caleb Brewster and Abraham Woodhull there was a message to gather. There were 6 coves on the Long Island Sound shoreline. The number of handkerchiefs she hung would show which cove to meet in.
 - Volunteers get up to represent Anna, Caleb, and Abraham looking for the signal on the laundry
