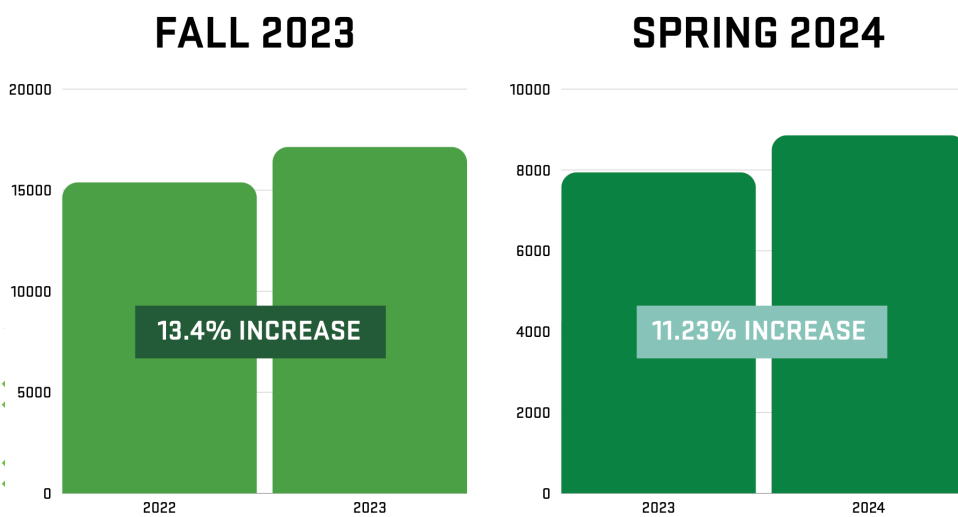
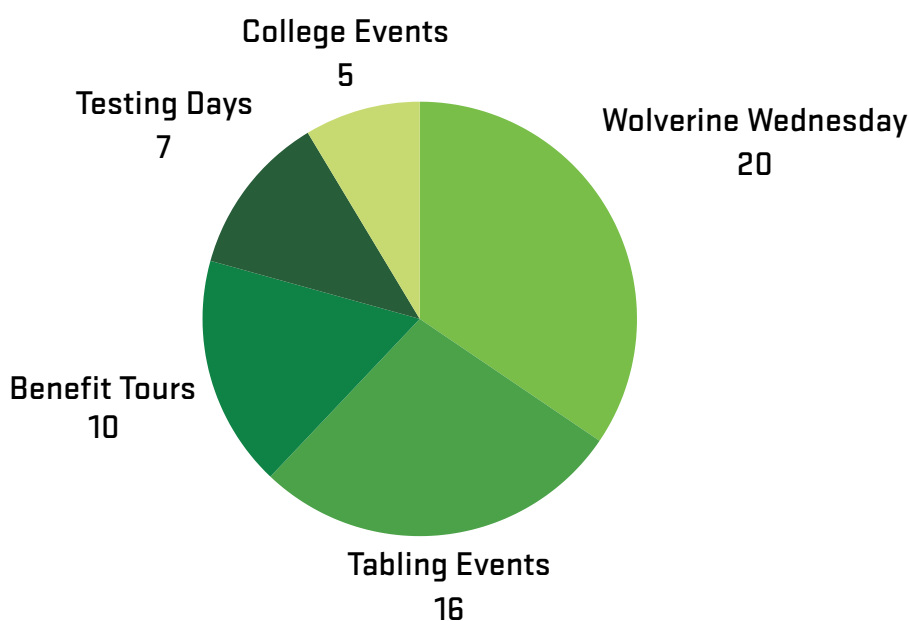


2023-2024 Top 10 Concurrent Enrollment Moments

1. We achieved a notable increase in registered Concurrent Enrollment students, with a **13.4%** rise in the fall of 2023, and an **11.23%** increase in the spring of 2024, resulting in a total growth of 2,761 Concurrent Enrollment students. We had just over **17,000 students enroll** this past academic year!



2. Our team coordinated events that reached over **5,500 students**. These included Wolverine Wednesday events in over 20 classes, 16 tabling events, 10 benefit tours, 7 testing days, and 5 college partnership events.



3. CE Advisors have been working hard to meet with as many students as possible. This year, our Advising team had the busiest year-to-date with **3,246 student appointments!**



4. This year, we have **101** students graduating with their General Education Certificate (GEC) and **328** students graduating with an associate's degree (AS)! We're excited to share that this was a record year for students graduating with an AS degree!

5. We successfully launched the department's inaugural texting platform, sending over **75,000 texts** to high school students within the first ten months. As a result, 15,445 students registered on time for Fall 2023, and 9,193 students registered on time for Spring 2024.

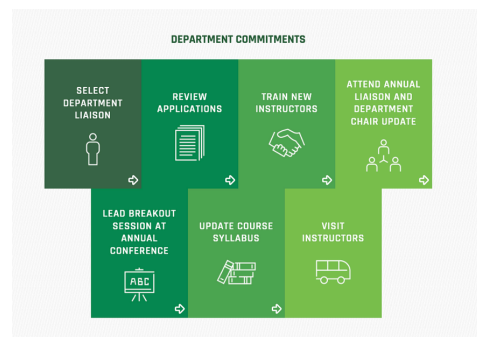
