

**I need to withdraw from my Class**

**Note:**  
 W's do not impact GPA. They are a placeholder for a grade. It shows you were in the class and dropped it. A few W's on a transcript do not affect scholarships, but it might if there are multiple W's.

Students cannot get their money back for withdrawing from a class.

Concurrent Enrollment classes cannot be repeated.

Example: A student takes ENG 1010, gets a B (or a W) and they want to take it again the next year to improve or replace the grade - they cannot. The student must graduate from high school and then re-take the class.
