The Tennessee Bureau of Investigation Forensic Services Division is seeking science majors with an interest in exploring opportunities in the forensic science field. Interns will have the opportunity to participate in hands-on scientific testing while assisting professional forensic scientists in the disciplines of Breath Alcohol Calibration, Toxicology, Forensic Chemistry, Forensic Biology/CODIS, Microanalysis, Latent Prints and/or Firearms.

In recent years, positions in the field of Forensic Science have become extremely competitive. Internship positions offer recipients the opportunity to gain valuable experience in a Forensic Services Laboratory.

Locations

Jackson/Knoxville/Nashville Regional Forensic Services Laboratory

Working Conditions

Most work will be conducted within the laboratory. Interns must be willing to work four or five 7.5 hr. days/week for the eight-week program

Education Requirements

Must be a college Junior or Senior majoring in a natural or physical science, forensic science, or another forensic related field. Must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher

In addition to the State internship prerequisites, successful candidates will also meet the following requirements:

- Must be a United States sworn citizen who is at least 18 years old;
- Recommendation letters from faculty members of the science department;
- Must have completed a minimum of eighteen semester hours in Chemistry;
- Must pass extensive background check
