

In Summer 2024, Institutional Engagement and Effectiveness attempted to contact all students who were attending summer semester. This survey was sent by email and was open from July 25 to August 11. Of the 11,417 students we attempted to contact, we received responses from 1,358 (11.9% response rate) and completed surveys from 1,234 (10.8% completion rate). The margin of error for results in this report is 2.6%. For more information contact Taylor Lovell (TLovell@uvu.edu).

### **Key Findings**

- Most popular reasons why students take summer classes:
  - Stay on track to graduate 58.4%
  - Graduate early 48.9%
  - More time during summer to take classes 18.1%
- Preference for class delivery methods:
  - Online only 78.8%
  - Hybrid 56.6%
  - In-person only 55.3%
- Most popular UVU-related reasons for taking less than 12 credits:
  - Offerings of specific classes 35.5%
  - Shortened class schedule 30.8%
  - Class difficulty 28.6%









### "How much do you prefer each of the following class times for classes taken during summer?"

■ Strong Preference ■ Slight Preference ■ Do Not Prefer




#### In-Person Delivery Method Preference, n = 716


