The Campus Climate Survey was developed at UVU by a committee of students, faculty, staff, and executives to evaluate the sense of belonging across campus and identify areas of improvement. This web-based survey was open during March and April of 2024. All non-concurrent enrollment students and all employees were invited to participate.

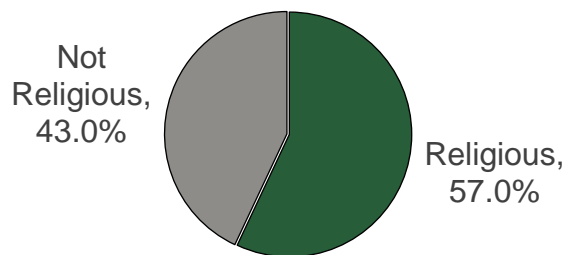

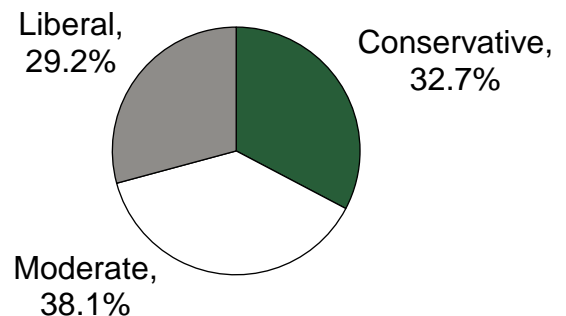

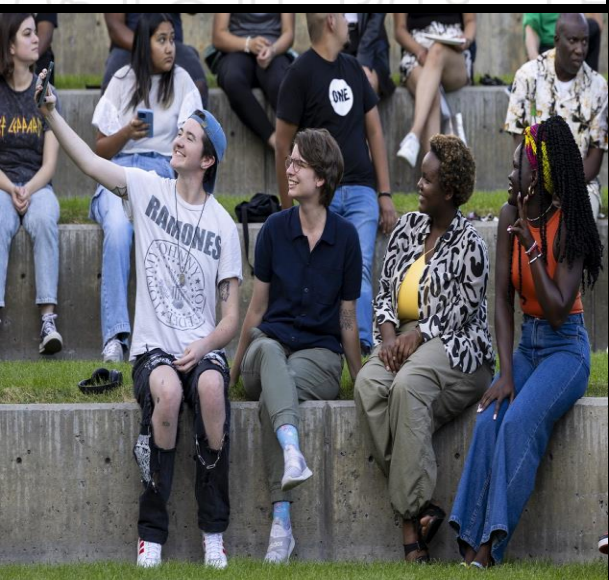
