One measure of outcomes for the B.S. degree in Emergency Services Administration (Emergency Care Emphasis) is student success in taking the National Registry Paramedic Exam. Over an eight-year period from 2009 to 2017, 343 UVU students took the Paramedic exam with a 88% pass rate. In 2017-2018, 65 students took the Paramedic exam with a 92% pass rate, which is 5% higher than the national results.
