Equitable Access: Textbooks and Course Materials

- Barns and Nobel contract expires next year looking for new options and contract
- Q&A
 - o **Q:** Students can opt out- so some depts would be subsidizing others?
 - **A**: Yes
 - **Q:** My textbook is OER, but I have an online homework system. To be clear, that gets included, correctly?
 - **A:** Yes, it will still be included
 - Q: Would hardware be included in this change?
 - A: You could continue including as a lab fee
 - Q: What benefit is there to lower cost departments in subsidizing higher cost programs?
 - A:
 - **Q:** Is the fee per semester or per class?
 - A: Standardized fee based on FT status
 - A: Goal is to have a tiered system which would allow students to opt in and out of individual pieces
