- Evelyn reminded everyone about the rules regarding finals week, emphasizing that finals must be held during the scheduled time to avoid conflicts. She also highlighted the importance of checking the academic calendar for the spring semester, including the interim study day.
- Raiden raised concerns about the academic calendar starting in the middle of the week, which
 causes scheduling issues for nursing classes. Evelyn acknowledged the concerns and mentioned
 that the academic calendar committee has debated this issue and conducted a survey, which
 showed overall positive feedback from students for the current schedule.

• Laurie discussed the ongoing exercise to prepare for potential budget reallocations or reductions. Each administrative unit is asked to map out what a 3%, 5%, 7%, or 10% reallocation or reduction would look like. The exercise aims to prepare for possible legislative requirements and ensure transparency and clarity. Laurie mentioned that the Deans have been provided with data packets, including information on majors, headcount, completions, student FTE, and faculty ratios, to help

them with the budget reallocation exercise. The goal is to make informed decisions and consider creative ways to address low-enrolled programs.

 Wayne emphasized the importance of engaging with legislators and being aware of the potential impact of the upcoming legislative session on higher education. He reminded everyone not to use university resources when communicating with legislators and to represent themselves as private citizens.
