Scholarship Vocab

“GPA must be...”

- This is based on your Cumulative GPA, not the GPA of the semester you are currently in

“Enrolled in a minimum of X credits”

- NOT how much you are enrolled in right now, but how much you will need to be in if you are awarded

“Preference given...”

- This is not a requirement. You can still apply if you don't meet this criteria.



Scholarship Vocab

“Demonstrated Financial Need”

- Your FAFSA Application determines this
- Whether it is preference or required, you still need to fill out a FAFSA
- FAFSA must be completed by February 23rd for you to keep your eligibility

“Updated/Completed Graduation plan in Wolverine Track”

- This means you have solidified what classes you will take every semester until graduation.
- Complete this by meeting with your academic advisor.

TIPS FOR A GOOD ESSAY

- *Make sure you are answering the questions*
- *Add a unique aspect to your essay that showcases who you are*
- *If there is no word limit, stick with 2 paragraphs MAX*
- *Document every scholarship question/answer you submit into a word doc*
- *Even if you don't know what you want to do, write about how you are dedicated to getting your degree!*
