The International Student Employment Program (ISEP) is a unique UVU work program that provides international students funding that is earned through on-campus student employment and paid at an hourly rate.

Requirements for Eligibility:

- Cumulative GPA 3.0 or higher.
- Maintain F-1 Status.
- Enrollment in regular non-ESL classes or in-status vacation.
- Preference will be given to students who have completed more semesters at UVU
- Graduate students not eligible.
