## **Admission Requirements**

- Verification of a bachelor's degree from an accredited institution
- A cumulative minimum GPA of 3.0 or a GPA of 3.0 for the last 60 credits of university coursework
- One or more years of experience as a classroom educator
- Three professional referrals who will provide recommendations through the application portal, including one from the current direct supervisor
- Submission of complete graduate application and essay
- A successful interview with the SOE Graduate Committee

# **Continuance and Graduation Requirements**

- Complete all program hours (30) and courses with a 3.0 gpa or higher
- Complete courses and requirements within five years
- Pass the state licensure exam as required by the USBE
- Score at the "2" level for clinical logs and state competencies and submit all required mentor signatures
- Score at the "2" level on all dispositions to be recommended for licensure
- Score at the "2" level on UELS evaluation
