

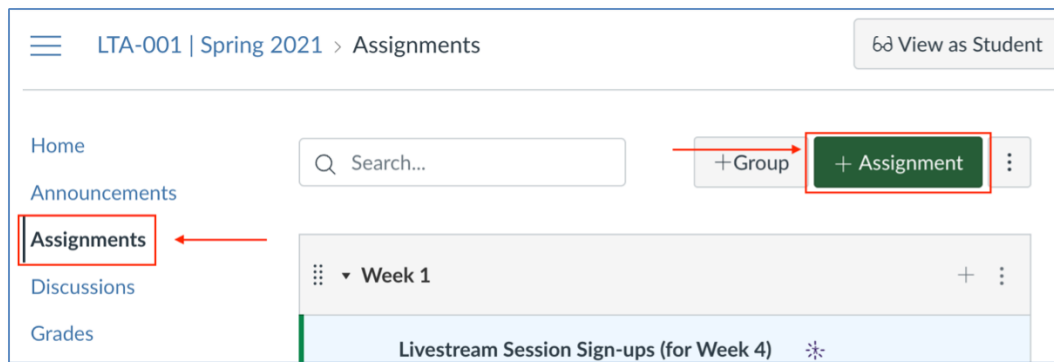
# Adding Copyleaks Plagiarism to a Canvas Assignment

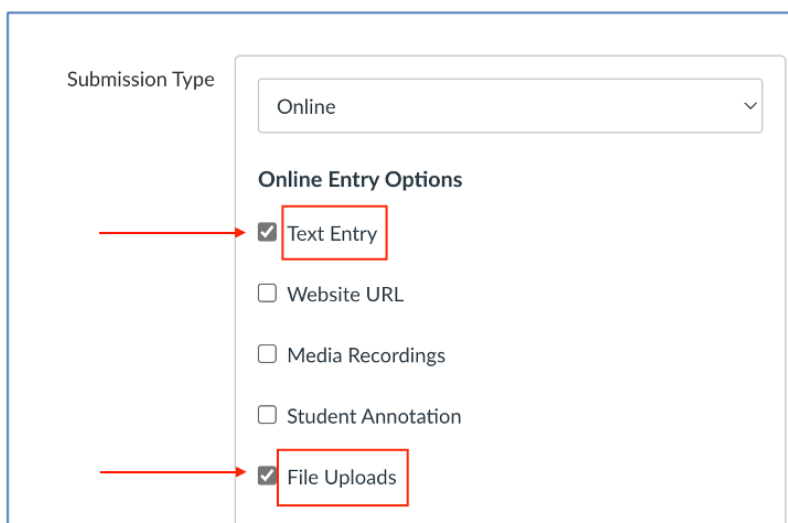
Copyleaks Plagiarism and AI Detection Tool is integrated UVU's Canvas instance and is available to all instructors to use within their Assignments.

These instructions outline how to add **Copyleaks** to a **Canvas Assignment**:

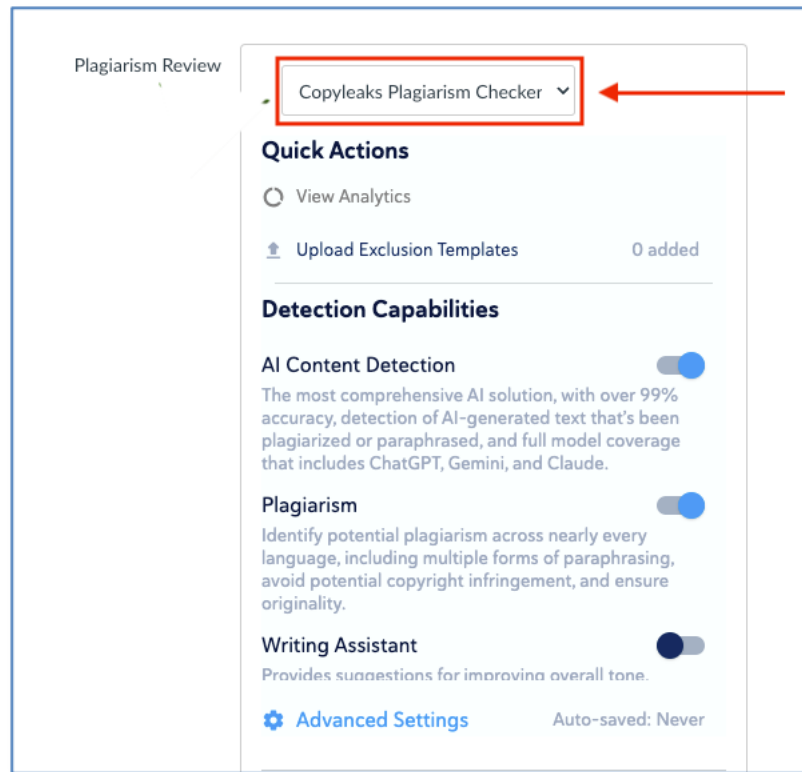
1. Log into Canvas and navigate to the course you want to add the Copyleaks Plagiarism Checker to an assignment.
2. On the left panel, select **Assignments** > click **+Assignment**



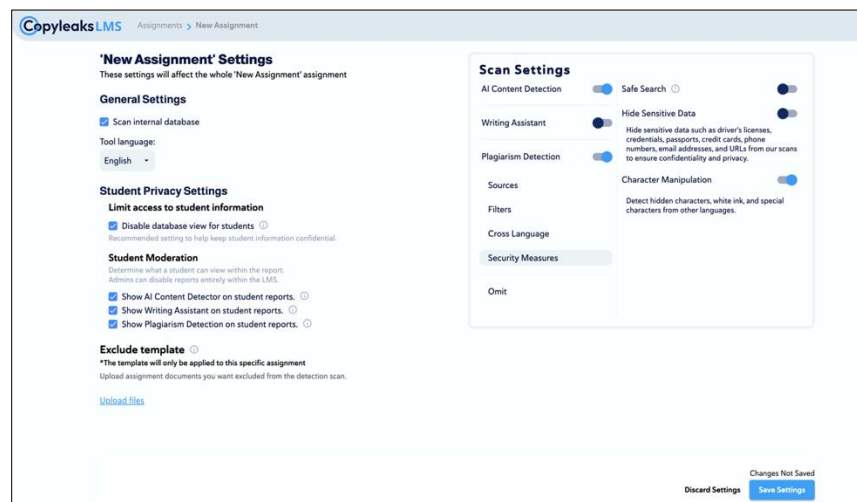
3. To add the Copyleaks Plagiarism Checker, change the assignment **Submission Type** to **Online**, and choose one or both of the following options: **Text Entry**, **File Uploads**.



- Next, Select Copyleaks Plagiarism Checker from the **Plagiarism Review** section.



- When the scan settings appear, you will be able to view general settings. Click on **advanced settings** to see your entire scan settings menu in a new tab.
- In the new tab you will be able to customize the settings you would like for your assignment. On the left there are General Settings. On the right there are 4 options which open to display more specific settings. Sources, Filters, Cross Language, and Security Measures.



7. Once you have decided on your settings, click **Save Settings** from the bottom right. A confirmation message will appear in the top right. Finally, you can close out the tab and return to Canvas.
8. **Save** or **Save & Publish** your assignment from within Canvas. Copyleaks recommends waiting up to 90 seconds between creating the assignment and making the first submission. This will allow Canvas to notify Copyleaks that the assignment has been created.
