

Media can be embedded in various elements:

- Announcements
- Assignments
- Pages
- Quizzes
- Discussions, etc.

**Steps:**

1. Open your course
2. After uploading media to your gallery
3. Select the location you'd like the media to appear in (e.g. Announcement, Assignment, Page, Quizzes etc.)
4. Select Edit (mode)
5. Select the App icon in the rich content editor (looks like a power plug)
6. Find "Embed Kaltura Media" and select "Media Gallery and Embed"



NOTE: Beginning Fall 2020 the Rich Content Editor interface has been updated by Instructure. This is the recommended method for embedding media in a Canvas course.
