Women's golfer Carly Dehlin Hirsch was named the Utah Golf Association Women's Player of the Year





CHAMPIONS: Classroom, Competition, Community

Volleyball played in its first national postseason tournament in program history

Men's Basketball made its third straight postseason appearance

Women's soccer's **Hannah Bruce** represented UVU at the **2019 NCAA Student-Athlete Leadership Forum**

Academic Victories (spring semester):

- 3.34 student-athlete cumulative GPA
- 20 straight semesters above a 3.0 GPA
- 31 student-athletes earned a 4.0 spring GPA
- 26 student-athletes have a cumulative 4.0 GPA





ONGOING NEEDS

Assistant Athletic Director for Marketing - \$96,414

 Athletic Marketing requires an additional full-time position to adequately promote all 16 sports at UVU. This will help us Engage and Build Community.

Volleyball Assistant Coach - \$73,512

 Volleyball does not have a second full-time assistant coach, which has been afforded to all other comparable programs and puts them at a competitive disadvantage. A new coach will help us **Achieve** and ensure **Student-Athlete Well-being**.

Tuition Waivers - \$100,000

 Increased athletic waivers are required to cover the rising scholarship costs for non-resident student-athletes. This will help the department and the student-athletes Achieve their educational goals and supports Student-Athlete Success.



ONE TIME NEEDS

UCCU Ballpark at doTERRA field – upgrades & renovations - \$100,000

• UCCU Ballpark field is being renovated with the doTERRA donation but additional upgrades are needed; including moving of the bullpens, outdoor batting cages and storage, press box upgrades, etc. This will provide an **inclusive** environment where student-athletes can succeed, and the facility will provide an improved **Student-Athlete Experience**.

Golf Practice Room Renovation - \$20,000

 Men's and women's Golf practice room was re-purposed to accommodate the larger Track staff and team meeting space. Previous track office needs to be converted to golf practice room. This supports Organizational Sustainability and a Standard of Excellence for the Student-Athlete Experience.

Radio Broadcast Equipment - \$7,200

 UVU Athletics radio broadcasting equipment is extremely outdated and needs to be replaced with quality digital equipment. This supports Organizational Sustainability and a Standard of Excellence for the Student-Athlete Experience.

FUTURE NEEDS

Student-Athlete Academic Center:

- Provide an adequate academic space for the 370 student-athletes and staff
- We are currently being out-recruited by our benchmarks because of our academic facility
- Bring the athletic department under one roof to improve communication and morale
- \$2 million donation from doTERRA has kicked off the fundraising efforts

Clyde Field/Softball Renovation:

 Clyde Field Renovation – Supporting facilities request for new sod, but also requesting to include press box/locker rooms for softball, men's & women's soccer.




