Unveiled in 2016, Roots of Knowledge is a 154-foot stained-glass exhibit in the Fulton Library's Bingham Gallery. Comprised of 80 windows and more than 40,000 pieces of stained glass, Roots of Knowledge was created by Holdman Studios in collaboration with Utah Valley University. From conception to completion, this privately funded project spanned twelve years, with four years of active construction. Showcasing a sweeping landscape of human achievement and pursuit of learning, the stained-glass windows inspire scholarship, cultivate passion, and ignite curiosity.

We welcome all visitors to engage with *Roots of Knowledge* through ongoing dialogue and compassionate curiosity. Diverse perspectives are necessary to interpret this work and its impact; understanding our rich and complicated past is essential to building a hopeful future.
