Are UVU events being cancelled?

Yes, effective March 16 and continuing through May 1, all university-sponsored events, conferences, large gatherings, and on-campus events are cancelled. This includes all events at the UCCU Center. Please contact your appropriate administrator if you have questions.

Can we still hold meetings?

Yes. Meetings necessary to perform critical administrative functions shall continue to be held, but we encourage the use of Microsoft Teams, other virtual alternatives, or small groups.

Are private functions at UVU being cancelled?

Yes.

Are athletic events cancelled?
