

Cisco AnyConnect Security Mobility VPN Client (Windows)

Installing the Cisco Client

1. Download Cisco VPN Client from My UVU

Login to My UVU at <https://my.uvu.edu/>

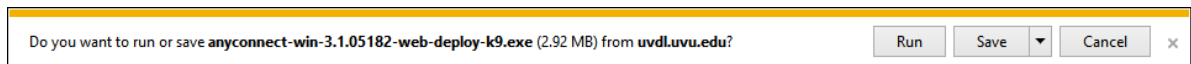
Navigate to the **Technology Services and Support** located on the left under the Employee drop down.

Expand the **VPN Installation** folder, under **Software Downloads** on the bottom right of the page.

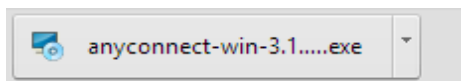
Download and install the latest AnyConnect-windows executable file.

Depending on the browser you are using, you may be prompted to **Run** or **Save** the executable file, or click on the .exe link.

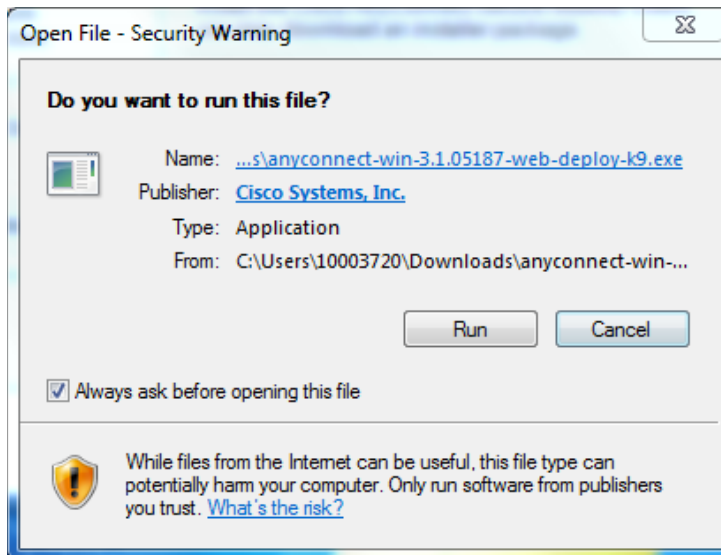
If you are using the IE browser, select the option to **Run** the file.



If you are using Google Chrome, click the **anyconnect-win-3.1....exe** link at the bottom, left corner of the screen.



Then, click the **Run** button.

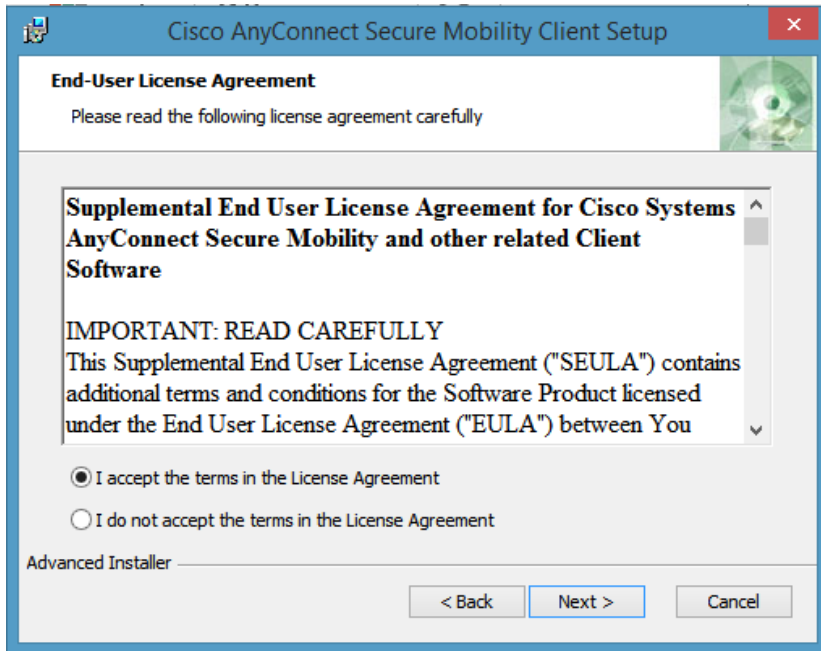


2. Install the AnyConnect Client

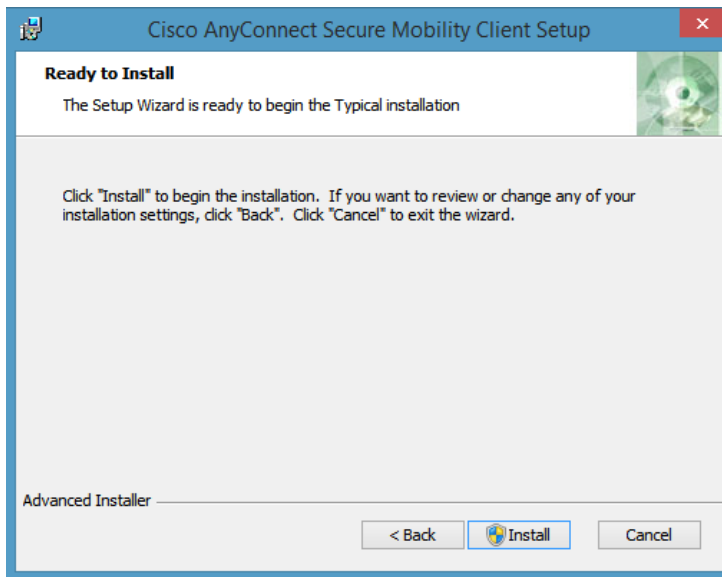
The Cisco AnyConnect Security Mobility Client Setup Wizard will open. Click **Next** to continue.



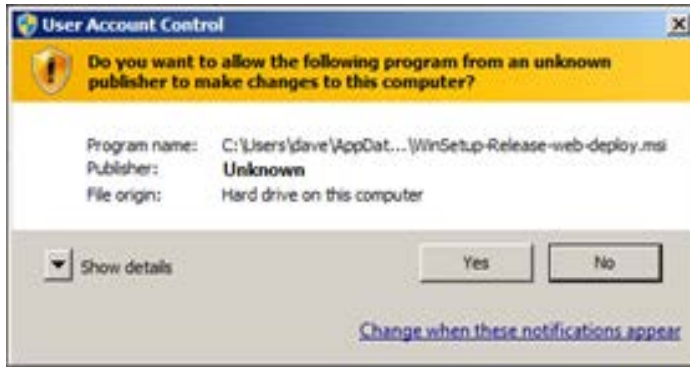
Accept the license agreement. Click **Next** to continue.



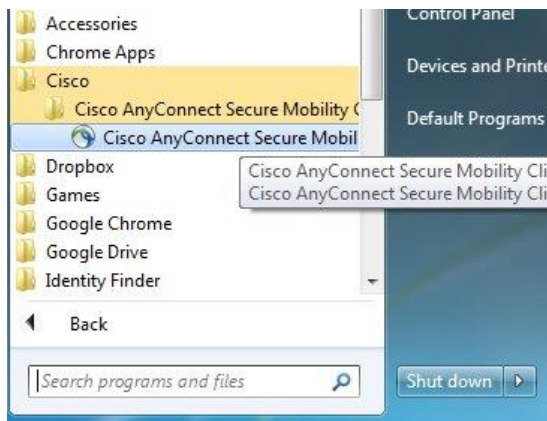
Click the **Install** button to begin a typical installation of the AnyConnect client.



Click **Yes** in the User Account Control window.



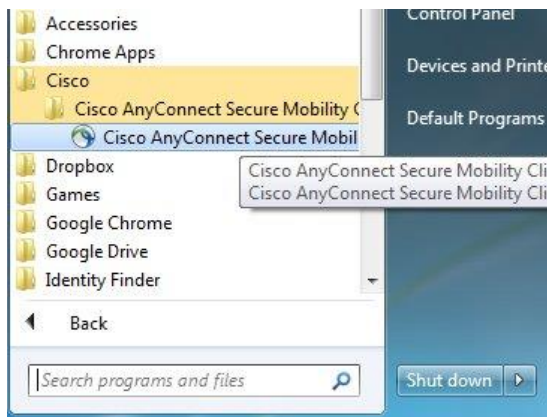
When the installation is complete, you should see a **Cisco** folder in your **Programs Menu** which contains the Cisco AnyConnect VPN client.



Connecting to the Cisco AnyConnect VPN Client

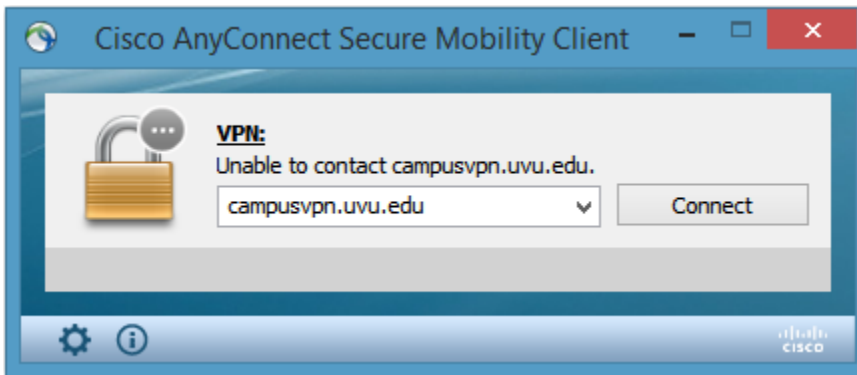
1. Run the VPN Client

Run the Cisco AnyConnect Secure Mobility Client from your Programs menu, Cisco folder.



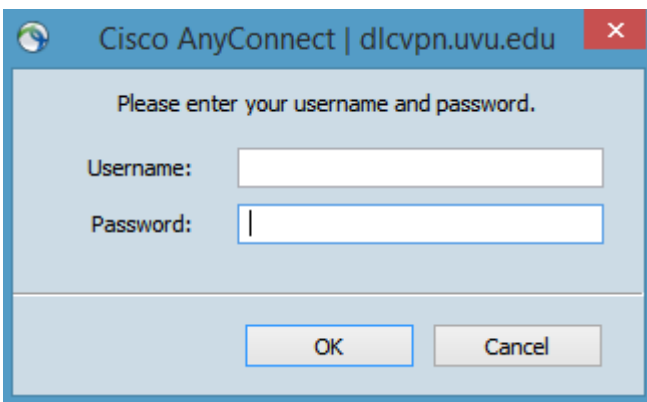
2. Enter the VPN server path


Enter campusvpn.uvu.edu in the VPN field and click **Connect**.



3. Authenticate

Enter your UVID and password. Click the **OK** button to establish the connection.



*When the AnyConnect client is disconnected from the VPN, the system tray will display this icon with a gold lock: 

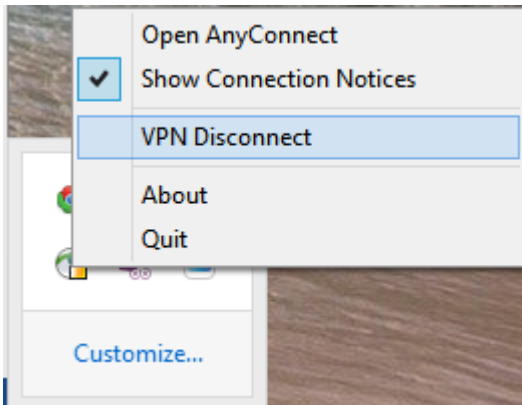
Disconnecting from the Cisco AnyConnect VPN Client.


1. Locate the VPN Client Icon

Right-Click the Cisco AnyConnect Client icon located in your system tray.

2. Disconnect

Select **VPN Disconnect**.



*When the AnyConnect client is disconnected from the VPN, the system tray will show this icon without the lock: 

The client will remain running until it has been disconnected (selecting the VPN Disconnect option from the system tray icon), or until the system has been rebooted.
