MISSION

The <u>Military-Affiliated Student Hub</u> (MASH) advocates for student veterans and military-affiliated individuals by providing access to education benefits, peer mentorship, resources, and a welcoming community.

LEARNING OUTCOMES

Military-Affiliated Student Hub staff aid the military community by providing camaraderie, mentorship, and knowledge about Veteran Affairs (VA), federal, and state education funding programs that assist with:

- Utilizing and navigating higher education and education benefit systems
- Creating a community of educated veterans
- Accessing veteran and military-affiliated resources

PROGRAMS AND SERVICES

Education Benefits and Academic Support

- Military-Affiliated Orientation: Updated online and in-person orientation specific to military-affiliated students that introduces MASH, the basics of VA education benefits, and other school and community military-affiliated resources.
- Veteran Success Scholarship: Qualifying military-affiliated students are eligible through academic achievement and individual need.
- VA Work Study Program: Helps work studies develop customer service skills, knowledge
 of VA benefits and resources, and opportunities for career growth.

Wellness and Camaraderie

- MIDAS Student Organization: A new organization for Military Individuals, Dependents, and Spouses (MIDAS) was formed in March 2023 to foster community outside of the classroom.
- VA VITAL Program: A veteran-centered wellness program dedicated to aiding student veterans in achieving academic success.
- Semester Wellness Checks: Connecting students to resources and benefit programs through peer-to-peer engagement.

Community Building

Campus Support: MASH provides a space for military-affiliated students to relax, study, and ask MASH employees questions about veteran student accounts and resources.

Veterans Day Events: MASH hosts a full week of events the week of Veterans Day to recognize and show support for the service and sacrifice of military-affiliated students, staff, and faculty.
