Internship Prep

can complete up to 6 credits of an Art History internship that will count toward your upper division elective requirements. It is recommended that complete an internship as part of your professional development and skill building.

1. Create a digital portfolio or resume website (include best works, classes and experiences only).
2. Come up with a list of 5 companies you want to work for after graduation and 5 companies you consider to be dream-job companies.
3. Research the jobs/companies on your list and figure out if they hire interns (keep a record of their website & contact info)

Math & English Requirements

All School of the Arts students must be continuously working toward the completion of their required Math & English courses. Non completion will result in the inability to register for 3000 level or higher courses and loss of opportunity to graduate with a degree.

Graduation Requirements

1. Completion of a minimum of 120 semester credits, 40 of which must be upper division.
2. Overall grade point average of 2.5 (C+) or above.
3. Residency hours - minimum of 30 credit hours through course attendance at UVU, with at least 10 hours in the last 45 hours.
4. Successful completion of at least one Global/Intercultural course.
