- 1. GPA of 3.0 or higher with no grade lower than a C in math QL, ENGL 2010, and content area courses.
- 2. Completion of all General Education and 70 percent of content area courses.

3. Pass LiveScan Criminal Background Check.

#### Summer Semester

Consider taking general education courses in summer semester to allow you to focus on your professional development within Theatre Arts during fall and spring semesters and stay on track for graduation.

#### **Graduation Requirements**

- 1. Completion of a minimum of 125 semester credits, 40 of which must be upper division.
- 2. Overall GPA of 3.0 (B) or above with no grade lower than a C in major required content courses and no grade lower than a B- in licensure and methods courses.
- 3. Residency hours minimum of 30 credit hours through course attendance at UVU, with at least 10 hours in the last 45 hours.
- 4. Successful completion of at least one Global/Intercultural course.
