BETTER FAFSA UPDATE

The 2024-2025 FAFSA form release was delayed by three months to December 30, 2023, causing significant delays in financial aid processing for students. Colleges will receive FAFSA data later than usual, which postpones financial aid award notifications until April or May, instead of the typical March. This delay has led some colleges to extend their decision deadlines beyond the traditional May 1 National College Decision Day to accommodate students. Prospective and current students are advised to complete their FAFSA promptly and stay in contact with financial aid offices to navigate the extended timelines effectively.


