JOB DESCRIPTION SUMMARY:

The full-time firefighter is a crew member under the direction of a shift Captain. The full-time firefighter will perform in all aspects of firefighting to include preparedness, fire suppression and rescue. Full-time firefighter responsibilities include, but are not limited to, maintaining fire stations, equipment, and apparatus, and participating in drills, training, and community outreach events. Duties include operating a variety of firefighting equipment and driving apparatus, participating in hazardous material incident response, performing extrication, assisting in fire prevention activities, ensuring accurate documentation of incidents, and assisting with fuels mitigation and other projects. The full-time firefighter will perform other duties as assigned.

The position is benefited and full time. Benefits include state retirement and department 401(K) contribution, paid vacation and sick accruals, holiday pay, health, dental and vision insurance, along with a department contribution to a health savings account.

The position has assigned shifts and is compensated for overtime when applicable. Shifts may change based on needs of the department. The full-time firefighter is expected to work towards and become certified as an Engine Boss as well as work on other firefighter certifications. They are expected to be available to travel up to 25% of the time for activities related to, but not limited to, training, fire assignments, support for natural disasters, and meetings.

This position is an integral part within Moab Valley Fire Protection District and is expected to meet all requirements of maintaining membership in the department. They are expected to maintain readiness to respond to calls. The full-time firefighter will follow all department policies and procedures and project a professional public image.

The full-time firefighter responsibilities may involve performing hazardous tasks requiring strenuous physical exertion for extended periods of time in cramped surroundings, hot, smoky environments with limited visibility, and at considerable heights.

BASIC REQUIREMENTS:

The following certifications are required and must stay current. New hires without certifications will be required to be certified within 12 months of hire :

- FF II
- WLFFII

Other requirements:

- Must be at least 18 years of age
- Must possess a valid drivers license

CONTINUOUSLY PARTICIPATES IN ONGOING TRAINING:

The full-time firefighter will complete training as required to meet Fire, State and federally recognized and accepted standards, which may include classroom and practical instruction as well as hands-on evaluations, examinations, and certification in a variety of areas. Training includes both structural and Wildland aspects of firefighting. The full-time firefighter must remain current on Fire service principles and practices. The full-time firefighter is expected to participate in a physical training program.
