

Fire Officer I – Assignment #17

Situation:

As a company officer, you understand that the best way to improve is to learn from past performance and experiences. In anticipation of conducting post-incident analysis (PIA) or post-incident reviews for your crew, you decide to develop a basic PIA job aid. You want the tool to be useful for all hazards. You plan to laminate it on a small card to keep in your go-bag for use immediately following emergency calls or training evolutions.

Assignment:

1. Review pages 339 and 340 in the text.
2. Identify the elements of a post-incident analysis that can be used for an all-hazards approach to any emergency incident or training evolution. This is not for fires only.
3. Compile these elements on a sheet of paper or card that can be used directly after events that need to be reviewed with your crew.

Requirements:

1. Place the elements of a complete PIA on a sheet of paper or card that can be used on-scene or directly after an emergency response, or type using a word processor program.
2. Make your PIA professional, brief, complete, and easy to use.
3. Design your PIA in a format you might present to your organization for possible implementation. (For example, as a laminated card – lamination is not required.)
4. Submit the assignment electronically as a .doc or .docx, or if scanned, .pdf.
