### **BEHAVEPLUS FIRE MODELING SYSTEM**

#### **Course Description**

This is a classroom-based skills course that serves to develop basic fire behavior knowledge and skills using the BehavePlus fire behavior software program.

- Introduction to basic BehavePlus operations
- Demonstrate and discuss the fire modeling operations found in the BehavePlus program.
- Help students become proficient in the use of BehavePlus in prescribed and wildland fire operations.

#### **Target Group**

Personnel involved in developing fire behavior predictions in both prescribed and wildland fire operations

#### **Course Prerequisites**

- Basic computer skills
- Basic fire behavior and fuels knowledge
