



COURSE DESCRIPTION

All students are responsible for bringing their **IRPG** (Incident Response Pocket Guide), **FLHB** (Fireline Handbook), and applicable **PTB** (Position Task Book) to each class session. Additional items to bring will be mentioned in the course acceptance letter. S-131. FIREFIGHTER TYPE 1

Course Description

Firefighter Type 1 (S-131) is a twelve-hour advanced firefighter course designed to meet the training needs of those who will fill the role of firefighter type 1 (FFT1) and/or incident commander type 5 (ICT5). This course is designed to be interactive in nature. It contains class discussions and several tactical decision games designed to facilitate meeting the course objectives. Topics include operational leadership, communications, LCES, and tactical decision making.

Objectives

Upon successful completion of this course, students should be able to:

- Identify position responsibilities and demonstrate the ability to apply the principles of Operational Leadership found in the Incident Response Pocket Guide (IRPG; PMS 461).
- Describe how to incorporate and maintain open lines of communication with appropriate personnel and identify documentation responsibilities.
- Identify "Look Up, Down, and Around" indicators and demonstrate the ability to apply the components of Lookouts, Communications, Escape Routes, and Safety Zones (LCES) as described in the IRPG.
- Demonstrate the ability to apply tactical decision-making procedures.

Target Group

Personnel desiring to be qualified as firefighter type 1 (FFT1) and/or incident commander type 5 (ICT5)

Course Prerequisite

Qualified as a firefighter type 2 (FFT2)
