S-261. APPLIED INTERAGENCY INCIDENT BUSINESS

Course Description

This is an instructor-led course designed for entry-level finance positions. The format is a mix of exercises, facilitated group discussions, and lectures supported by PowerPoint presentations. Students work directly from the Interagency Incident Business Management Handbook for most of the exercises.

Objectives

Upon successful completion of this course, students should be able to describe the roles and responsibilities of the following positions, and demonstrate proficiency in the skills/knowledge required to perform each position's tasks:

- Equipment time recorder (EQTR)
- Compensation for injury specialist (INJR)
- Claims specialist (CLMS)
- Personnel time recorder (PTRC)

Target Group

Personnel desiring to be qualified as one or more of the financial positions: equipment time recorder (EQTR), compensation for injury specialist (INJR), claims specialist (CLMS), or personnel time recorder (PTRC)
