





DUAL-MISSION MODEL

Utah's integrated dual-mission model works by combining the community college and university functions through:

- Open admissions
- Sharing resources
- Sharing faculty
- Sharing infrastructure
- Reducing noninstructional costs
- Eliminating the need for transfer articulation
- Directing more resources to educate students
- Coordinating curriculum



BUDGET PRIORITIES

COMPENSATION AND MANDATORY INCREASES

- 5% cost of living adjustment
- Compensation funded at 100%
- Mandatory cost increases to insurance premiums
- Risk management rate increases

PERFORMANCE FUNDING (USHE: \$40M, UVU: \$6.3M)

- Enhance student success and accelerate completion (\$800K)
- Institutional and workforce readiness (\$500K)
- Flexible educational opportunities and timely completion (\$1.7M)
- Digital transformation/cybersecurity (\$1.2M)
- High-demand program expansion (\$2.1M)

CAPITAL FACILITIES

Legislature to release \$80M appropriation for UVU Scott M.
 Smith Engineering and Techology Building.

USHE REQUESTS

- Healthcare workforce expansions (USHE: \$6M)
- Computer science workforce expansions (USHE: \$5.5M)
- Equipment funds (USHE: \$3M, UVU: \$470K)
