About International Mountain Day

International Mountain Day (IMD) is celebrated annually to promote awareness for mountain communities around the globe. December 11th was officially declared as International Mountain Day by the United Nations General Assembly Resolution 57/245 in December 2002. The Mountain Partnership under the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (FAO-UN) is the United Nations voluntary alliance to work together for mountain peoples and environments. UIMF Activities and Contribution to IMDs: International Mountain Day has been celebrated at Utah Valley University (UVU) every year since 2010 by members of the Utah International Mountain Forum (UIMF), a coalition of student clubs (see:www.utahimf.org). UIMF celebrates IMDs as a student engaged learning (SEL) approach, with faculty providing advice only as needed. Through SEL students spearhead all IMD activities: raising funds for the event, designing agenda, providing protocol, logistics, etc. For the last 12 years, UVU has been the only academic institution in North America to celebrate IMD on an annual basis. For the third time, it will be observed when UIMF is a chapter of the United Nations Association of the United States of America (UNA-USA), which establishes a formal partnership with UIMF in November 2019.

Event objectives:

- To raise awareness about mountain targets implementation by addressing challenges faced by mountain communities face worldwide, like climate change, food insecurity and outmigration and bring them to the focus of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development;
- 2. To report about UIMF contribution to the mountain targets implementation:
 - At the 65th session of the Commission on the Status of Women (CSW65) at the UN in New York during March, 2021.
 - Plans for UIMF participation at the 66th session of the Commission on the Status of Women (CSW66) at the UN in New York during March, 2022.
 - 3. To recognize students, faculty and local community who contributed towards the advocacy of mountain targets during 2021.
