





# Challenges and Strategies

## **Importance of Tourism in Greece**

- Economic and Cultural Significance: Tourism is a major economic driver, with picturesque islands, historical landmarks, and cultural traditions attracting millions annually.
- <u>Transformation Over Time</u>: Shift from simpler, localized tourism in the 1980s to modern mass tourism reliant on intermediaries and digital marketing.



## Challenges of Over-tourism

### Environmental Impacts:

- Degradation of landscapes and ecosystems (e.g., Santorini faces waste management and water shortages).
- Damage to mountain areas (e.g., deforestation, soil erosion, biodiversity loss).

### Economic Issues:

- Over-reliance on mass tourism and intermediaries reduces service quality and increases environmental and community pressures.
- Uneven economic benefits, with high concentration in iconic destinations like Mykonos and Santorini.



### Socio-cultural Effects:

- Commodification of culture traditions simplified or altered for tourists, leading to loss of authenticity.
- Rising living costs and conflicts between residents and tourists.

### Safety Concerns:

The strain on infrastructure, leading to issues like increased road accidents during peak seasons.

## Strategies for Sustainable Tourism

### Environmental Sustainability:

- Implement eco-friendly lodging and waste reduction programs.
- Invest in sustainable tourism infrastructure, such as low-impact trails and rainwater harvesting.

### Cultural Preservation:

- Support local artisans and promote authentic traditions through communitybased tourism initiatives.
- Enforce architectural harmony in tourism development to maintain cultural authenticity.

## Sustainable Mountain Development

### Challenges:
