In 1997 The Economic and Social Council of the UN, identified the following ways for providing sustainable development to mountainous areas in its resolution 1997/45:

- Awareness raising;
- Coordination of regional and international cooperation;
- Exchange of information and experiences;
- Support for sub-regional and inter-regional agreements on the protection of mountain areas and their sustainable and equal development;
- Promotion of regional, national and international institutional systems.

During the General Assembly of the UN November 19, 1998 the resolution 53/24 was adopted, which supported the proposal of the Kyrgyz Republic for designating the year 2002 as the International Year of Mountains (IYM). The resolution further encouraged all governments, the UN and other entities **"to** take advantage of the International Year of Mountains in order to raise awareness [to the rest of the world] of the importance of sustainable mountain development."

In adherence to the resolution of the UN Assembly, the Bishkek Global Mountain Summit (BGMS) was organized as the concluding event of IYM. The Summit pursued to achieve the following objectives:

1. To identify and to summarize the socio-economic, environmental, and political challenges to the sustainable development of mountainous regions;

2. To work out and to adopt the foundational document on sustainable mountain development- on the base of Bishkek Mountain Platform;

3. To launch the "International Mountain Partnership" program, announced by the Government of the Swiss Confederation at Johannesburg Summit on Sustainable Development (2002), that was envisioned to promote decisions of Bishkek Mountain Platform;

4. To initiate a celebration of the annual International Mountain Day through the accepting UN General Assembly resolution.

After the conclusion of the International Year of Mountains, another UN resolution (A/RES/57/245) was adopted during the General Assembly on January 30, 2003, that recognized the final documents of the Bishkek Global Mountain Summit, and The Bishkek Mountain Platform, in particular.

Paragraph 2 of the resolution says that: "[We welcome] the success achieved during the International Year of Mountains, during which numerous activities and initiatives were undertaken at all levels, ...that catalyzed a strengthened interest for sustainable development and poverty eradication in mountain regions."

Paragraph 9 of the resolution says that: "Encourages all relevant entities of the United Nations system, within their respective mandates, to continue their constructive

collaboration in the context of the follow-up to the International Year of Mountains, consistent with the mandates specified in the Bishkek Mountain Platform;"

This means that the UN General Assembly positively evaluated the results of the International Year of Mountains and the Bishkek Global Mountain Summit.

In the preparation and celebration of the International Year of Mountains and the Bishkek Global Mountain Summit, the international community has provided and continues to provide all possible assistance to developing and vulnerable mountain nations. However, these countries continue to be centers of social and economic stress, especially taking into account recent threats and challenges, such as climate change. There remains an urgent need to refocus on the international community on the urgent socio-economic problems of isolated mountainous regions in order to further development and conceptually sound, global approach and identify solutions to these new global threats.

A whole series of special events were held throughout the International Year of Mountains in different countries across the world such as Nepal, Peru, Germany, Morocco, France, China, and Japan, among others. The Bishkek Global Mountain Summit was held from October 28 – November 1, 2002, acting as the concluding event of that year. As a result of these events and conferences were held throughout the year, the UN General Assembly adopted the resolution proclaiming in December 11 as "The International Mountain Day".

In honor of the 10th anniversary of the International Year of Mountains and the Bishkek Global Mountain Summit, and as a follow-up event to the U.N. conference on sustainable development (RIO+20) in Brazil in June, 2012, a number of conferences, round tables, and workshops are planned from October till December 2012. The concluding event, the International Scientific and Practical Conference: "Mountains and Climate," will be held on December 11, 2012. The following table provides the information on each of the scheduled events.
