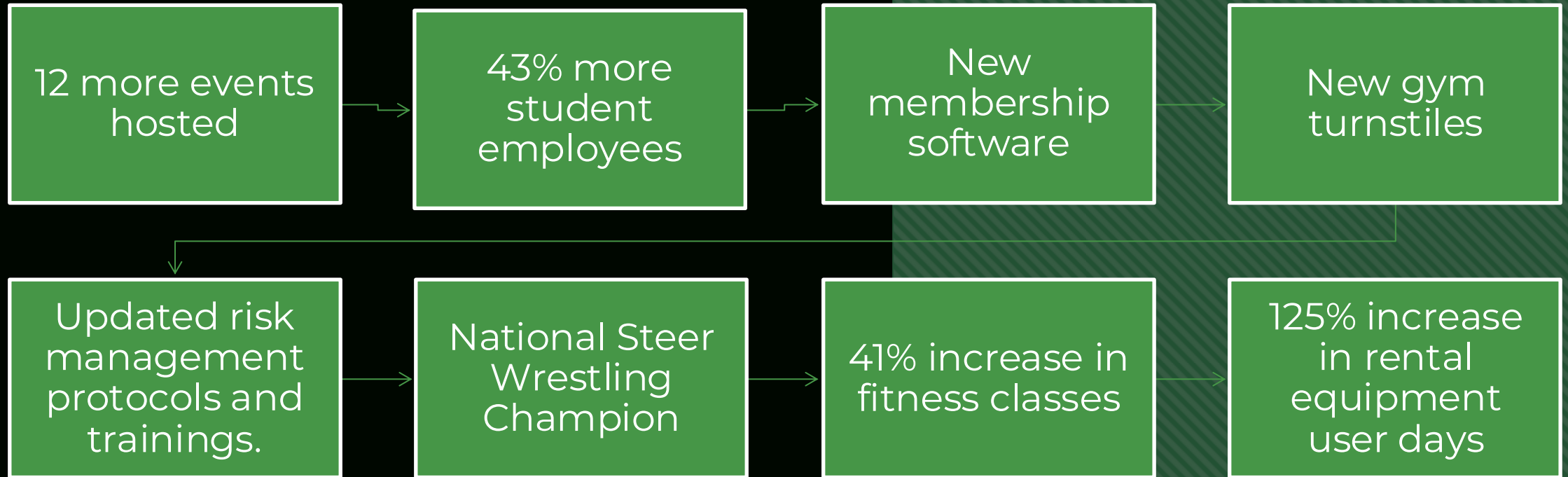

# Tier 1 Competitive Sports

## Ice Hockey, Lacrosse, Rugby (M&W)

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Tier 1 sports are all sports that are high risk for injuries and are contact sports. These sports governing bodies, USA Rugby, NCHA, MCLA, required medical personal in attendance for all games.

- 18 medical referrals
- 1 surgical referral
- 29 covered events
- 14 concussion post-injury tests
- 62 new injury evaluations
- 966 follow up visits



- Men's Lacrosse - 2nd place D1 & 2023 RMLC champions
- Men's Rugby - 118 out of 238 D1 & compete against NCAA D1 sponsored programs under USA Rugby.
- Ice Hockey - 23rd D2 & ended 23-24 season with the highest raking in the last 10 years.



# Tier 1 Competitive Sports Funding

- Team are majority self-funded. Most of these athletes are competing at a very high level in their sport and need to both fund their participation through working a job outside of their normal classroom duties.

Men's Lacrosse - \$3500/player

Men's Rugby - \$400/player

Ice Hockey - \$4000/player

Women's Rugby - \$150/player

- These teams practice weekly, 3-4 times per week and compete around 15-30 times a year.
- 203 Tier 1 Athletes (46 out of state)

## Alternative Funding Options

- User Fee ( \$89 per person)
- Eliminating Rec & Wellness programming/PT staffing
